AN ACT relating to writs in municipal courts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

All writs in civil actions before any municipal or  
2 police court may be made returnable at any term of  
3 such court, to be holden not less than seven, nor more  
4 than sixty days from their date.
