[H. R. 3.] RESOLVE in favor of roads passing through the Indian township in Washington county.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be 2 appropriated to be expended on that part of the 3 Houlton and Baring road which lies in the Indian 4 township. Also that the sum of one hundred fifty 5 dollars be appropriated to be expended on the road 6 leading from the Houlton and Baring road in said 7 Indian township to Grand Lake stream. Said sums 8 to be expended under the supervision of the governor
