STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 5.] RESOLVE for the purchase of the Maine state year book and legislative manual.

Resolved, That the secretary of the state be authorized to contract for seven hundred copies of the Maine state year book and legislative manual, at a cost not to exceed one thousand dollars, namely : one hundred copies eight vo. for exchanges ; one hundred copies octavo, suitable for binding ; one copy, to be delivered by the secretary of state, on or before the tenth day of May, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, to each member and officer of the legislature of eighteen hundred and seventy-six ; and the balance to be delivered to the secretary of state, of which balance one copy shall, by said secretary, be delivered to each member and officer of the legislature of eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, and the remainder be delivered to the heads of the departments for their use.
