STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 1.] RESOLVE in aid of the town of Mount Chase,
Penobscot county.

Resolved, That there be paid to the town of Mount
2 Chase from the state treasury the sum of four hundred
3 dollars for purpose of repairing and rebuilding bridge
4 over "Shin pond" in said town. Said amount to be
5 expended under direction of county commissioners of
6 Penobscot county,
7 This act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Petition of John Gardner and others for aid to repair bridge and roads in Mt. Chase.

Petitioners represent that the town of Mt. Chase is greatly burdened by the necessity of keeping in repair the roads and highways in said town, one of which is known as the Shin Pond road, used for the most part by lumbermen who do an extensive business in a region beyond this. And that the bridge over Shin Pond stream is greatly in need of repairs, being hardly passable. That the town is very poor, with a small population; that the State has realized during the past year over \$1,800 from the sale of lands in said town. They therefore ask that a reasonable sum be appropriated to said town to repair said bridge and roads.
