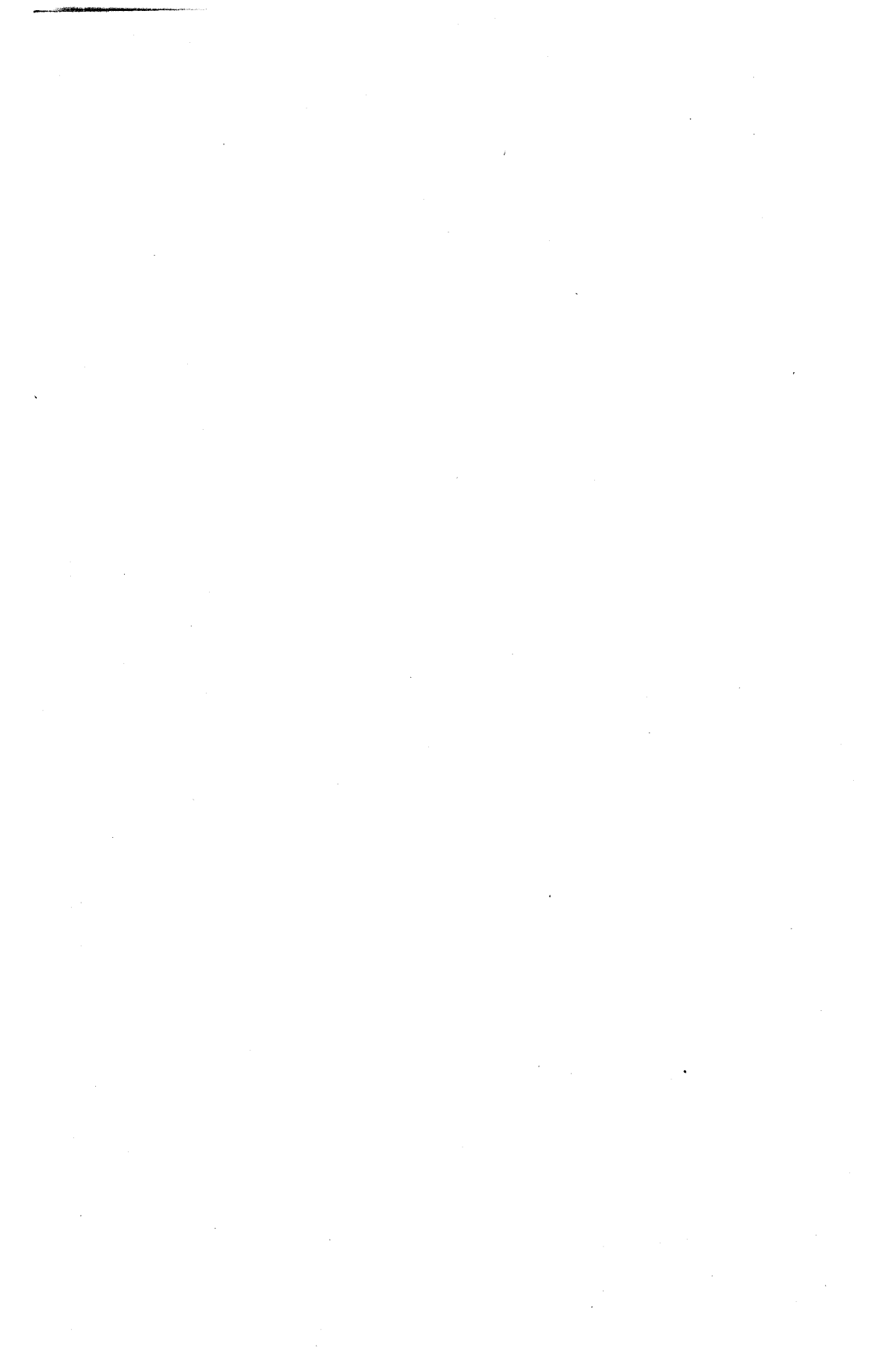

STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 6.] RESOLVE in favor of the state centennial commission.

Resolved, That the sum of ten thousand dollars be
2 appropriated for the befitting exposition of Maine's
3 resources at the forthcoming international exhibition at
4 Philadelphia, to be expended (or so much thereof as
5 shall be necessary) under the care and direction of the
6 state centennial commission, subject to the approval of
7 the governor and council.
