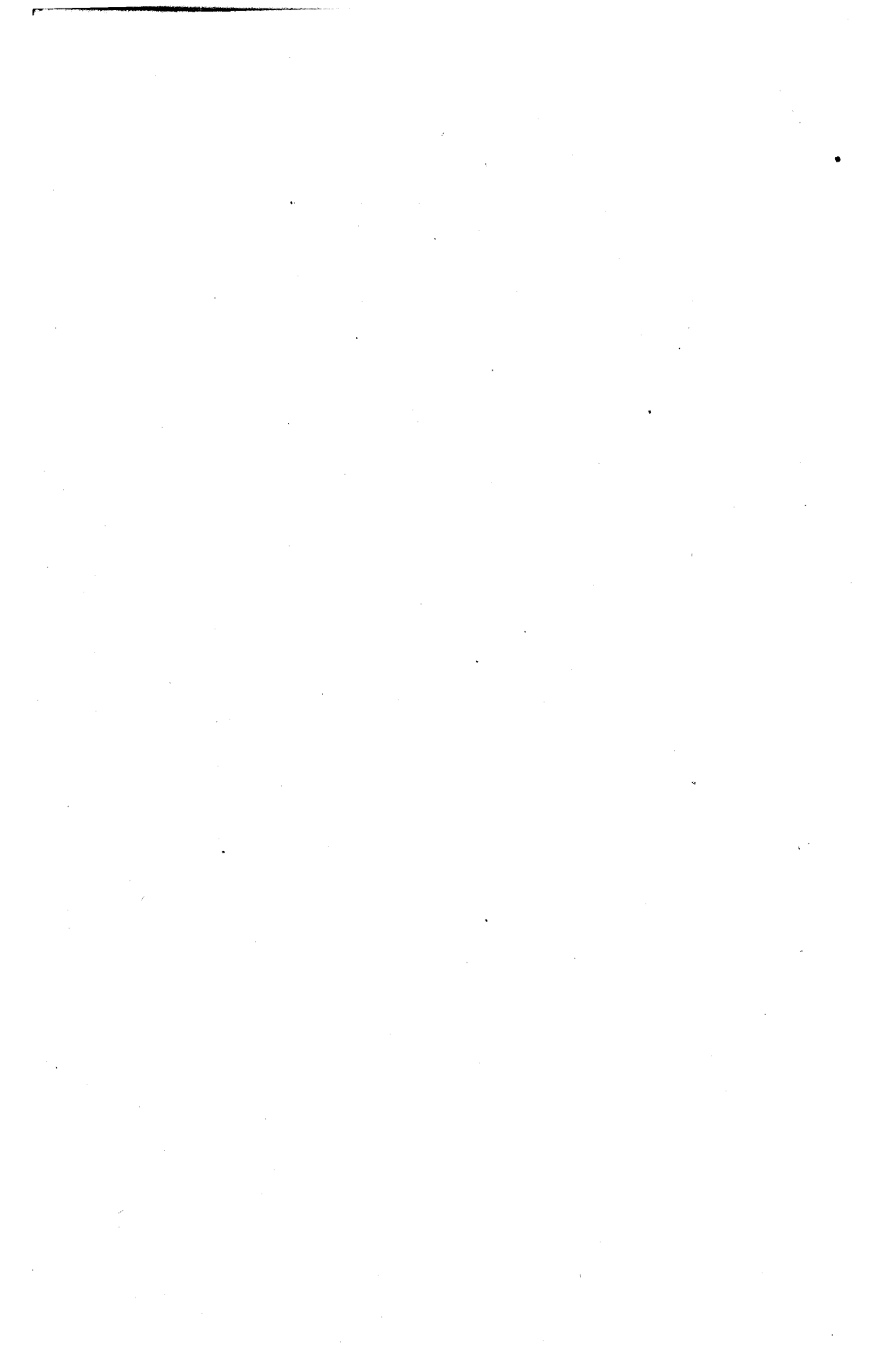

2 the sum of one hundred dollars in aid of Sola Coly,
3 member of the Penobscot tribe of indians, on account
4 of loss by fire, to be paid to said Sola Coly by the
5 agent of said tribe.
