STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 13.] RESOLVE in favor of the normal school at Farmington and the normal school at Castine.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated 2 from the normal school fund, two thousand five hundred and thirty-three dollars and ninety-four cents, for 3 the use of the western normal school at Farmington, 4 and the eastern normal school at Castine, and to be 5 used for the following purposes :

7 For the western normal school at Farmington.

8 For slating roof of school building, four hundred 9 dollars; for library, four hundred and eighteen dollars 10 and ninety-four cents; for radiators for school building, 11 three hundred and sixty dollars; for transit, two hundred 12 and ten dollars; for spectroscope, forty-five dol- 13 lars.

14 For eastern normal school at Castine.

15 For painting school building, one hundred dollars;

16 for boilers for school building, two hundred dollars; for
17 laboratory, three hundred dollars; for grading and
18 fencing lot, five hundred dollars.
