STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 2.] RESOLVE authorizing an appropriation for a
chemical fire engine and hose.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred and thirty-
2 seven dollars (337) be, and the same hereby is
3 appropriated to pay for the chemical fire engine and
4 hose, now in possession of the state for the protection
5 of the state-house.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This machine was contracted for informally by several members of the Council ; has been in possession of the State several years, and is not yet paid for ; is a valuable machine, and is needed for the protection of the State House. Has already done valuable service at fires in the neighborhood.
