[S. 15.] RESOLVE in favor of Charles J. Schumacher.

Resolved, That the governor and council be authorized to audit bill of Charles J. Schumacher of Portland, the same to be paid from the state treasury, the sum of thirty-five dollars, for a painting of State of Maine-coat of arms, the same having been placed in the Washington mansion, under the direction of the "Ladies' National Mt. Vernon Association," together with similar paintings of coats of arms of all the states of the union.
