STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 17.] RESOLVE in favor of the Maine industrial school for girls.

Resolved, That the sum of four thousand nine hundred and thirty-four dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the use of the Maine industrial school for girls at Hallowell, to meet the current expenses of the ensuing year, the same to be expended by the trustees of said school; *provided,* the trustees will make to the governor and council a full and detailed report of the expenditure of the above appropriation.
