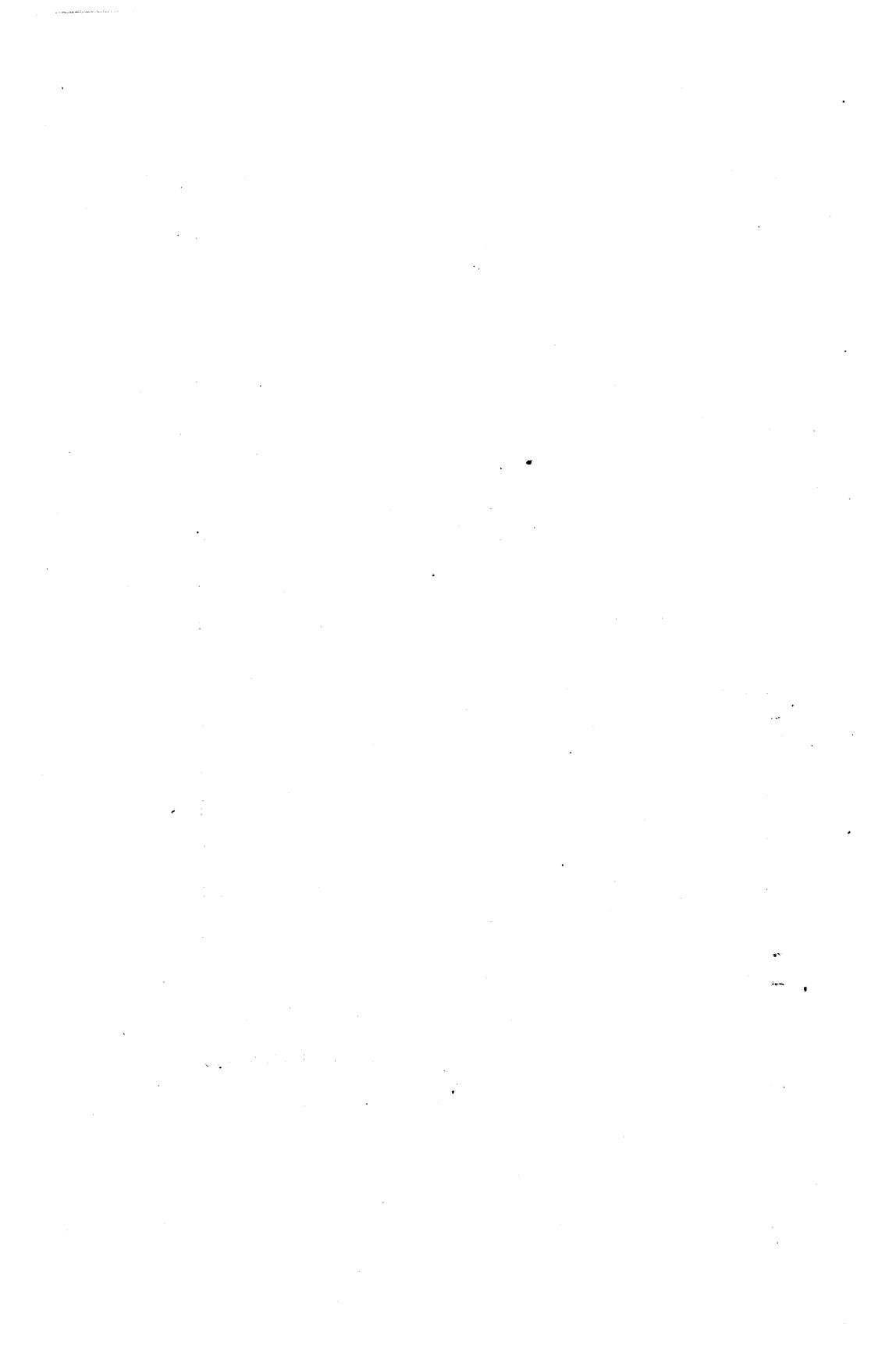

STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 24.] RESOLVE to more fully perfect the records of the adjutant general's office, and to encourage the writing of regimental histories of Maine troops in the war of eighteen hundred and sixty-one.

Resolved, That the adjutant general, under the direction
2 of the governor and council, be authorized to collect
3 diaries or obtain copies of them, letters, personal
4 accounts and incidents of the battle field, camp and
5 hospital, or any other interesting and valuable material
6 for army history, and to arrange and index all such
7 matter and data under the name of the regiment to
8 which it may appertain, and that the sum of two hun-
9 dred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
10 be yearly appropriated for this purpose.
