STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

[S. 66.] AN ACT to amend chapter thirty-seven public laws of eighteen hundred seventy-two, relating to foreclosure of mortgages on real estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter thirty-seven of the public laws of eighteen 2 hundred seventy-two is hereby amended, by adding 3 thereto the following words: "and shall apply to 4 each and all the modes prescribed by statute for the 5 foreclosure of mortgages on real estate," so that section 6 six mentioned in said chapter, shall read as follows:

7 Sect. 6. The mortgagor, or person claiming under
8 him, may redeem the mortgaged premises within three
9 years next after the first publication, or the service of

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10 the notice mentioned in the preceding section, and if 11 not so redeemed his right of redemption shall be for-12 ever foreclosed; *provided*, the mortgagor and mortgagee 13 may agree upon a less time, not less than one year, in 14 which the mortgage shall be forever foreclosed, which 15 agreement shall be inserted in the mortgage and be 16 binding on the parties, their heirs and assigns, and 17 shall apply to each and all the modes prescribed by 18 statute for the foreclosure of mortgages on real estate.
