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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

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[S. 71.] AN ACT to amend section fourteen of chapter one hundred and forty-two of the revised statutes, relating to the reform school.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section fourteen of chapter one hundred and forty-two of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows :

4   *Sect.* 14. One or more of the trustees shall visit  
5 the school at least once in every four weeks, examine  
6 the inmates, in the school-room and work-shop, and  
7 register and regularly keep a record of their visits  
8 in the books of the superintendent. Once in every  
9 three months, the school, in all its departments, shall  
10 be thoroughly examined by a majority of the board of

11 trustees, and a report made showing the results there-  
12 of. Annually, on the first day of December, an ab-  
13 stract of these quarterly reports shall be prepared and  
14 laid before the governor and council for the information  
15 of the legislature, with a full report of the superin-  
16 tendent, stating particularly, among other things, the  
17 offence for which each pupil was sentenced and his  
18 place of residence. A financial statement, furnishing  
19 an accurate detailed account of the receipts and ex-  
20 penditures for the year terminating on the last day of  
21 November preceding, shall be also furnished.
