STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the supreme judicial court for the
county of Sagadahoc,

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section seventeen of chapter seventy-
2 seven of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, by
3 striking out the words " the December term for civil
4 business only," in the thirty-third and thirty-fourth
5 lines thereof.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent
2 with this act, are hereby repealed.
