STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT in aid of the deaf and dumb school of the city of Portland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows ·

SECTION 1. An amount of money equal to that
2 heretofore allowed by the state for each pupil sent
3 from this state to the Hartford asylum for the deaf
4 and dumb, shall be allowed and paid to the city of
5 Portland for each pupil who attends the deaf and
6 dumb school of said city of Portland; *provided* that
7 said pupil is a resident of this state.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
