

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for the removal of the remains of General Henry Knox from the cemetery at Thomaston to the grounds of the state capitol at Augusta.

Resolved, That the governor and council be authorized 2 and directed, with the consent of the relatives of the 3 deceased, to cause the remains of General Henry 4 Knox to be removed from the cemetery at Thomaston, 5 to the grounds of the state capitol at Augusta, and 6 there suitably interred; and that for this purpose the 7 sum of three thousand dollars be and is hereby ap-8 propriated from the treasury of the state.
