RESOLVE authorizing the land agent to convey by deed to John Estes a lot of land.

Resolved, That the land agent be and is hereby au-

- 2 thorized to convey, by deed, lot numbered four, in
- 3 Oakfield plantation, to John Estes, waiving further
- 4 settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Statement of facts in relation to the petition of John Estes for a deed of lot of land No. four, (4) in Oakfield plantation.

The State Land Agent issued a certificate of lot No. 4, in Oakfield plantation, in Aroostook county, to Cyrus F. Coolbroth, on the second day of June, 1871, and said Coolbroth commenced the performance of the settling duties on the same that year, but had not the means to enable him, unaided, to accomplish the end.

He applied to John Estes of Lincoln, who furnished supplies for said Coolbroth and his family to enable him to do a part of said settling duties, and said Coolbroth afterwards, to wit: on the 16th day of November, 1871, assigned his right and interest in said lot, with the certificate of the same, to said Estes as payment for the supplies furnished, with the right to perform any settling duties required by the State laws not then performed, which said Estes has done, and the books of the Land Agent show that said lot has been fully paid for, and all the settling duties performed, except establishing an actual residence on said lot, which with said Estes, the petitioner, is impracticable.
