STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of M. L. Stewart.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and is hereby
2 authorized to convey to M. L. Stewart lot number one
3 hundred twenty-five in township number twelve, range
4 four, west from the east line of the state, on payment
5 of the full amount of road labor due on said lot at
6 fifty cents per acre, and proving to the land agent that
7 he is the lawful holder of the land certificate of said
8 lot, waiving further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled for 1877 :

Your petitioner would respectfully represent that one M. H. Stewart, father to the petitioner, contracted with the State for lot No. 113, in township 12, range 4, Aroostook County, and your petitioner contracted for lot No. 125, lying directly south of his father's lot, or as it now stands (by reason of the road running on the northern line of his father's lot) lies in the rear of first mentioned lot, and without any road leading to or near said lot 125. The father and son, or your petitioner, have cleared on the first mentioned lot about 70 acres, and have erected buildings thereon so as to be near the road. And your petitioner would further represent that the road work is done on said contract for lot No. 125, and asks that your honorable body would authorize the Land Agent to give to your petitioner a deed of said lot No. 125, township 12, range 4, waiving all further settling duties.
