IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT repealing sections five, six, seven and eight, chapter thirty, revised statutes, relating to bounty on bears and wolves.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sections five, six, seven and eight, chapter thirty, 2 revised statutes, relating to bounty on bears and 3 wolves, are hereby repealed.
