STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT entitled an act authorizing any town in the state to elect its municipal officers for a term of three years, in the same manner as the county commissioners are now elected.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Any town in the state may elect its 2 municipal officers for a term of three years, in the 3 same manner as the county commissioners are now 4 elected, providing the town shall so vote.

SECT. 2. Any town adopting the provisions of this 2 act, shall the first year elect one of its selectmen and 3 assessors for one year, one for two and one for three 4 years ; after which one shall be elected annually for 5 three years.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
