RESOLVE in favor of S. W. Stratton.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and is hereby 2 authorized to convey by deed to S. W. Stratton, lot 3 numbered ten, section thirteen, in the town of Wash-4 burn, on payment of thirty-five cents per acre in cash.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled :

We, the subscribers, citizens of Aroostook county, respectfully represent that April 29, A. D. 1871, S. W. Stratton purchased and received a certificate from the Land Agent of lot of land numbered ten (10), section thirteen (13), containing one hundred and sixtythree (163) acres, in the town of Washburn. That he has paid for (under the new act of 1876) and done all the settling duties required of actual settlers on said lot, except to establish his residence thereon; that he is now living on a treaty lot adjoining; that his buildings are situated but a few rods from the line of said lot. He therefore asks your honorable body to empower the Land Agent to give him a deed of said lot, as in duty bound will ever pray.
