RESOLVE in favor of Albion W. Stratton.

Resolved, That the land agent be, and is hereby

- 2 authorized to convey by deed to Albion W. Stratton,
- 3 lot numbered fourteen, section thirteen, in the town
- 4 of Washburn, on payment of thirty-five cents per acre
- 5 in cash.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled:

We the subscribers, citizens of Washburn, County of Aroostook, respectfully represent, that April 29, A. D. 1871, Albion W. Stratton purchased of and received from the Land Agent, a certificate of lot of land, numbered fourteen (14), section thirteen (13), in the town of Washburn, containing seventy-six acres—that said Stratton has paid for and done all other settling duties required of actual settlers according to law, except to establish his residence thereon; that said lot is not of itself suitable for a farm; that he is now living on a treaty lot adjoining said lot No. 14, and his buildings situated within a few rods of the line of said lot. He therefore asks your honorable body to instruct the land agent to give him a deed of said lot, and as in duty bound will ever pray.
