STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT additional to chapter one hundred and one of the
public laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and
seventy-six, relating to the equity powers of the
supreme judicial court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1 Chapter one hundred and one of the
2 public laws of the year one thousand eight hundred
3 and seventy-six, is hereby amended, by adding at the
4 end thereof the words, “and any property or interest
5 conveyed in fraud of creditors,” so that the said
6 specification, as amended, shall read as follows :

7 “*Tenth.* In suits for the re-delivery of goods or
8 chattels taken or detained from the owner and secreted

9 or withheld, so that the same cannot be replevied, and
10 in bills in equity by a creditor or creditors, to reach
11 and apply in payment of a debt, any property right,
12 title or interest, legal or equitable, of a debtor or
13 debtors residing or found within this state, which
14 cannot be come at to be attached on writ, or taken
15 on execution in a suit at law against such debtor or
16 debtors, and which is not exempt by law from such
17 attachment and seizure, and any property or interest
18 conveyed in fraud of creditors.”

SECT. 2. This act shall have effect when approved.
