STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to proceedings in criminal cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

No indictment shall be quashed or adjudged bad, nor 2 shall the proceedings in any criminal case be arrested 3 or reversed by reason of any defect or want of form or 4 irregularity in the venires for grand or traverse jurors, 5 or in the issuing or return of the same, or in the draw-6 ing or summoning of grand or traverse jurors, unless 7 it shall appear to the court that the respondent has 8 been or may be injured thereby.
