IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section eight of chapter seventy-eight
of the revised statutes, relating to the adjournment of
the session of the county commissioners' court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section eight of chapter seventy-eight
2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking
3 out the word "two," in the fourth line, so that said
4 section, as amended, shall read as follows :

SECT. 2. Two commissioners constitute a quorum ;
2 when only one attends, he may adjourn to a convenient
3 time and place ; when no one attends, the clerk may
4 adjourn as provided in section twenty of chapter
5 seventy-seven.
