## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section eight of chapter seventy-eight of the revised statutes, relating to the adjournment of the session of the county commissioners' court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section eight of chapter seventy-eight 2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking 3 out the word "two," in the fourth line, so that said 4 section, as amended, shall read as follows:

SECT. 2. Two commissioners constitute a quorum; 2 when only one attends, he may adjourn to a convenient 3 time and place; when no one attends, the clerk may 4 adjourn as provided in section twenty of chapter 5 seventy-seven.
