STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT amending an act entitled "an act for the better protection of lobsters."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That section one, chapter thirteen of the public laws

- 2 of eighteen hundred and seventy-five, is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out the words, "first day of
- 4 August and the first day of October," and inserting
- 5 the words, "fifteenth of July and fifteenth day of
- 6 September," so that said section, as amended, shall
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sect. 1. That section one, chapter two hundred
- 9 and ten of the public laws of eighteen hundred and
- 10 seventy-four, is hereby amended by striking out the

- 11 words, "catch, sell or expose for sale," in the first
- 12 line, and all after the third line of said section, so
- 13 that said section shall read: No person shall preserve,
- 14 within the limits of the state of Maine, any lobsters,
- 15 between the fifteenth day of July and the fifteenth
- 16 day of September of each year.
