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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
SEVENTY-SEVEN.

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AN ACT amending an act entitled “an act for the better  
protection of lobsters.”

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

That section one, chapter thirteen of the public laws  
2 of eighteen hundred and seventy-five, is hereby  
3 amended by striking out the words, “first day of  
4 August and the first day of October,” and inserting  
5 the words, “fifteenth of July and fifteenth day of  
6 September,” so that said section, as amended, shall  
7 read as follows :

8 *Sect. 1.* That section one, chapter two hundred  
9 and ten of the public laws of eighteen hundred and  
10 seventy-four, is hereby amended by striking out the

11 words, “ catch, sell or expose for sale,” in the first  
12 line, and all after the third line of said section, so  
13 that said section shall read : No person shall preserve,  
14 within the limits of the state of Maine, any lobsters,  
15 between the fifteenth day of July and the fifteenth  
16 day of September of each year.
