STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section four of chapter seventy-eight of the public laws of eighteen hundred seventy-six, relating to the erection of fish weirs and wharves in tide waters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section four of chapter seventy-eight of the public 2 laws of eighteen hundred seventy-six is hereby amended 3 by adding to said section after the word act, the words 4 "provided that nothing in this chapter shall be so con-5 strued as to apply to fish weirs, the materials of which 6 are wholly removed annually," so the section as 7 amended shall read as follows :

8 Sect. 4. No fish weirs shall hereafter be erected, or 9 wharf extended, erected or maintained, except in ac-

10 cordance with the provisions of this act, *provided*, that
11 nothing in this chapter shall be so construed as to apply
12 to fish weirs, the materials of which are wholly removed
13 annually.
