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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor of John M. Brown.

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*Resolved,* That the land agent be, and is hereby authorized to convey by deed to John M. Brown lot of land numbered ten in township number sixteen, in the seventh range of townships west of the east line of the state, when said Brown shall have shown to the satisfaction of land agent that said lot has been fully paid for in road labor.
