## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section eight of chapter seventeen of the revised statutes, relating to nuisances.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section eight of chapter seventeen of the revised

- 2 statutes is hereby amended by adding after the words,
- 3 "any valuable building," in the third line thereof,
- 4 the words, "not owned by such person or his lessor,
- 5 which was," so that said section, as amended, shall
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sect. 8. If a person carries on the business of
- 8 manufacturing gunpowder, or of mixing or grinding
- 9 the composition therefor, in any building within eighty
- 10 rods of any valuable building, not owned by such per-
- 11 son or his lessor, which was erected when such busi-

- 12 ness was commenced, the former building shall be
- 13 deemed a public nuisance; and such person may be
- 14 prosecuted accordingly.
