STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing clothing for the Portland Montgomery Guards.

Resolved, That the sum of thirteen hundred dollars be 2 and is hereby appropriated for uniforming the Port-3 land Montgomery Guards, as contemplated by the act 4 approved February fifteen, eighteen hundred and 5 seventy-six.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The volunteer company, known as the Portland Montgomery Guards, were by chapter 86, public laws of 1876, made subject to the duties and granted all the privileges provided by chapter 29 of the laws of 1869, but by omission no provision was made for an appropriation for clothing.
