STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Baileyville.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be,
2 and is hereby appropriated to the town of Baileyville,
3 to be expended on the Baring and Houlton road in
4 said town, said sum to be expended under the direc-
5 tion of commissioners of Washington county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Baileyville has a population of 377, and a valuation of \$53,641. The road in question extends through said town a distance of eight miles and more, a great part of the distance being through a wilderness. There are a great many teams passing over said road, heavily loaded with hides, one way, and with leather the other way, making it a very severe tax on so small a town to keep said road in repair.
