## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter six, section fifty-three of the revised statutes, relating to repairs of ways in unincorporated townships.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fifty-three of chapter six of the revised statutes

- 2 is hereby amended by adding after the word "thereon"
- 3 in the sixth line, the words "and they may make as
- 4 many divisions as are equitable, conforming as nearly
- 5 as is convenient to known divisions and separate own-
- 6 erships, and assess upon each a sum proportionate to
- 7 the value thereof and the benefits likely to result to
- 8 the same by such repairs," so that the first clause of
- 9 said section shall read as follows:
- 10 Sect. 53. Said county commissioners, in September
- 11 annually, by one or more of their board, shall make an

annual inspection of all county roads in the unincorporated townships, and tracts of land in their counties,
and thereupon make an estimate of the amount needed
to put them in repair, so as to be safe and convenient
for public travel, assess such amount thereon, and they
may make as many divisions as are equitable, conforming as nearly as is convenient to known divisions and
separate ownerships, and assess upon each a sum proportionate to the value thereof and the benefits likely
to result to the same by such repairs; and cause so
much thereof as they deem necessary for the purpose
aforesaid, to be expended on said roads within one year
thereafter, and such assessment shall create a lien
thereon for the payment thereof.
