STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, relating to administrators, executors and trustees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter sixty of the public laws of eighteen hundred

- 2 and seventy-six, is hereby amended by inserting after
- 3 the word "cases," in the third line, the words, "and
- 4 when they reside beyond the limits of this state, be-
- 5 fore a commissioner for the State of Maine or a United
- 6 States consul," so that said chapter, as amended, shall
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 "Administrators, executors and trustees, are hereby
- 9 authorized to make oath to their several accounts
- 10 before a justice of the peace in all cases, and when

- 11 they reside beyond the limits of this state, before a
- 12 commissioner for the State of Maine or a United States
- 13 consul, when no objection is made by parties interested
- 14 to the allowance of said account."
