STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Maysville.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be, 2 and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose 3 of paying existing debts for repairs on the bridge 4 across the Aroostook river in said town.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Maine.

The undersigned, County Commissioners of the county of Aroostook, would represent that the bridge crossing the Aroostook river, in Maysville, is very expensive to keep in repair, and a grievous burden to said town. Many other towns are interested to have said bridge safe and convenient for public travel, and really the whole community, from Houlton to Fort Kent, are dependent upon it for crossing said river; but the burden of repairs falls entirely upon the town of Maysville, which seems to us to be unfair and unjust, and believing that strict justice to all would be attained by an appropriation from the State Trensury to aid in making said repairs, and as the town of Maysville has expended a large sum upon said bridge the past season, we respectfully recommend that the sum of twelve hundred dollars be appropriated as a partial reimbursement to said town.
