STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Bangor children's home.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars be
2 and hereby is appropriated for the benefit of the Ban-
3 gor children's home.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

As there are supported at the Children's Home at Bangor, fifteen orphan children of soldiers, and as the State granted the sum of two thousand dollars for their support, the Committee think that they should at least be granted one half of that sum the present year.
