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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor of the Passamaquoddy Indians.

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*Resolved,* That there be paid from the state treasury,  
2 to be expended under the direction of the governor  
3 and council, to the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe  
4 of Indians, for the benefit of said tribe, as follows :  
5 For May dividend, four hundred dollars ; for Novem-  
6 ber dividend, three hundred dollars ; for distressed  
7 poor, sixteen hundred dollars ; for agricultural pur-  
8 poses, five hundred dollars ; for bounty on crops for the  
9 year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven,  
10 three hundred dollars ; for ploughing, one hundred and  
11 fifty dollars ; for salary of governors, fifty dollars each ;  
12 for salary of lieutenant governors, twenty dollars each ;  
13 for wood, two hundred dollars ; for educational pur-  
14 poses, three hundred dollars ; for salary of priest, one  
15 hundred dollars ; for dressing for land, one hundred

16 dollars; for contingent fund, one hundred dollars; for  
17 salary of agent, three hundred dollars; for repairs on  
18 road at Peter Dana's point, fifty dollars; for stove and  
19 chimney for hall at Peter Dana's point, thirty dollars;  
20 also for overdrawn balance of the year one thousand  
21 eight hundred and seventy-six, three hundred seventy-  
22 five dollars and eight cents.
