STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE laying a tax on the several counties of the
state.

Resolved, That the sums annexed to the counties in
2 the following schedule, are hereby granted as a tax on
3 each county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed,
4 collected and applied for the purpose of paying the
5 debts and necessary expenses of the same, and other
6 expenses ordered by law, to wit: Androscoggin,
7 thirty-three thousand dollars; Aroostook, fourteen
8 thousand five hundred dollars; Cumberland, eighty-
9 four thousand dollars; Franklin, seven thousand dol-
10 lars; Hancock, fifteen thousand dollars; Knox, twen-
11 ty thousand dollars; Kennebec, thirty-six thousand
12 dollars; Lincoln, nine thousand dollars; Oxford,
13 twelve thousand dollars; Penobscot, sixty thousand
14 dollars; Piscataquis, six thousand dollars; Sagadahoc,
15 sixteen thousand dollars; Somerset, twelve thousand

16 dollars; Washington, twenty thousand dollars; Waldo,
17 eighteen thousand dollars; York, twenty-five thou-
18 sand dollars.
