STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the East Oxford Agricultural Society," approved February twenty-eighth, A. D. eighteen hundred sixty-one.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section third of an act entitled "an act 2 to incorporate the East Oxford Agricultural Society," 3 is hereby amended, by adding thereto the following 4 words, viz: "including the right to assess upon and 5 collect from its members such sums as are necessary 6 at any time to liquidate its indebtedness, provided a 7 majority of the members present at any regular meet-8 ing duly called for such purpose shall so vote," so 9 that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

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10 Sect. 3. This society shall have all the powers and 11 privileges and be subject to all the liabilities and re-12 strictions usually granted to and imposed upon similar 13 societies, including the right to assess upon and col-14 lect from its members such sums as are necessary, at 15 any time, to liquidate its indebtedness; provided, a 16 majority of the members present at any regular meet-17 ing duly called for such purpose shall so vote.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
