STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section second of chapter sixty of the revised statutes, relating to divorce.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section second of chapter sixty of the revised stat-

- 2 utes is hereby amended, so that said section shall read
- 3 as follows:
- 4 Sect. 2. A divorce from the bonds of matrimony
- 5 may be decreed by the supreme judicial court, in the
- 6 county where either party resides at the commence-
- 7 ment of proceedings, when the judge deems it reason-
- 8 able and proper, conducive to domestic harmony and
- 9 consistent with the peace and morality of society, if
- 10 the parties were married in this state, or cohabited
- 11 here after marriage; or the libellant resided here when
- 12 the cause of divorce accrued, or had resided here in

- 13 good faith one year prior to the commencement of
- 14 proceedings. Either party may be a witness, and
- 15 when such divorce is granted, except for the cause of
- 16 adultry, shall not marry again.
