STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT requiring accounts and claims against towns, cities, etc., to be verified by oath.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Every person presenting an account or

- 2 claim against any town, village corporation, city,
- 3 county, or the state, for services rendered, articles
- 4 furnished, or expenses incurred, may be examined,
- 5 under oath, to make true answers, by the officer or
- 6 officers whose duty it is to audit such account, claim
- 7 or demand; and before the same shall be approved and
- 8 allowed by said officer or officers, said claimant shall
- 9 be required to make oath that the same is just and
- 10 true.

Sect. 2. All auditing officers are hereby authorized 2 to administer oaths required by the preceding section.
