STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize Samuel Cunningham to navigate Androscoggin pond and Dead river by steam.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Samuel Cunningham, his associates and 2 assigns, are hereby vested with the sole and exclusive 3 right to navigate by steam, the Androscoggin pond 4 and Dead river, in the towns of Wayne and Leeds, for 5 the term of twenty years ; *provided*, that if the said 6 Cunningham, his associates and assigns, shall neg- 7 lect for the term of one year to navigate the said pond 8 and river by steam, this act shall be void.

SECT. 2. Said Cunningham, his associates and as- 2 signs, are hereby vested with all the powers, duties 3 and privileges usually granted to such corporations.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
