STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

[S. 23.] AN ACT in relation to municipal and police courts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Where a municipal or police court has a regular seal
2 of court and a recorder, and has jurisdiction in any
3 action where the amount of damage claimed exceeds
4 twenty dollars, real estate and interests in real estate
5 attachable on writs from the supreme judicial court,
6 may be attached on writs or taken on executions from
7 such municipal or police court, where the amount of
8 the debt or damage, exclusive of costs, exceeds twenty
9 dollars.
