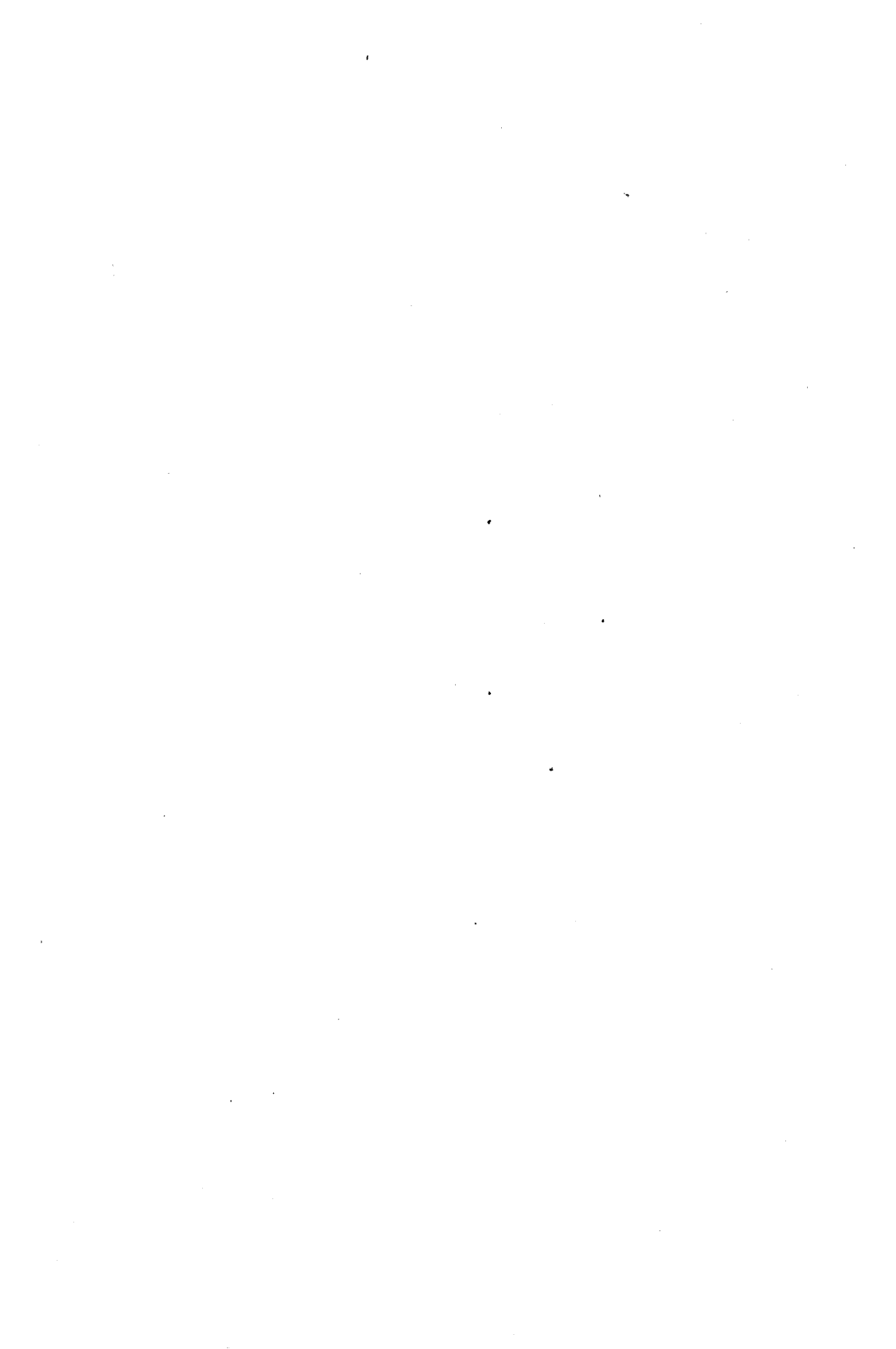

STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 11.] RESOLVE in favor of the Maine state college
of agriculture and the mechanic arts.

Resolved, That the sum of fifteen thousand two hundred eighteen dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of paying existing debts, for instruction, building farm house, and contingent expenses of the Maine state college of agriculture and the mechanic arts, the same to be in full for any and all expenditures by the state on account of said college for the current year.
