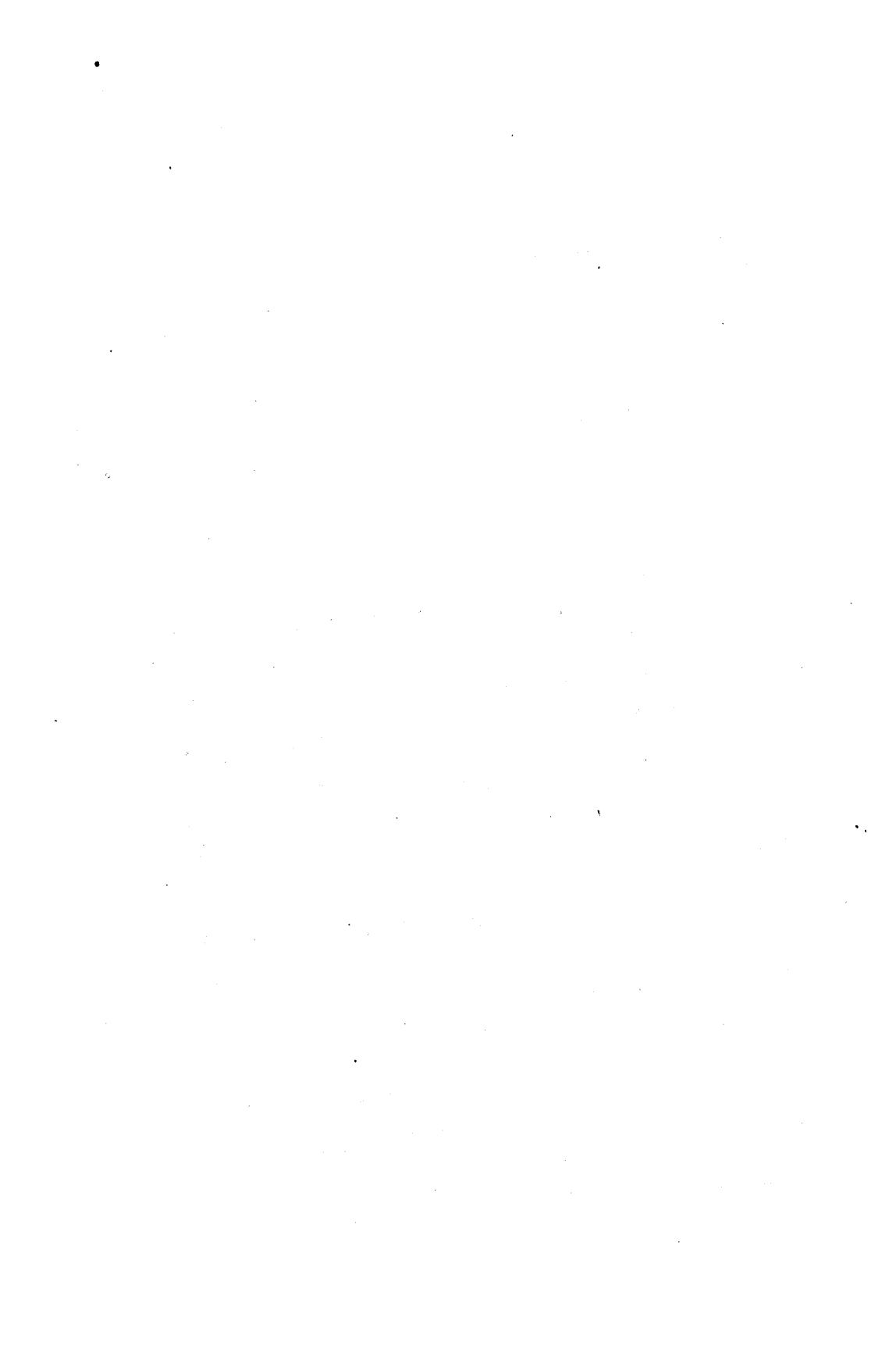
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

[S. 43.] AN ACT to continue in force chapter ninety-eight of the public laws of eighteen hundred seventy-two, and chapter two hundred and three of the public laws of eighteen hundred seventy-four, relating to pensions for disabled soldiers and seamen.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter five of the
2 public laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and
3 seventy-two, and of chapter two hundred and three of
4 the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four
5 are hereby continued in force for one year from the
6 thirty-first day of December, one thousand eight hun-
7 dred and seventy-six.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
