STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

[S. 52.] AN ACT additional to section six of chapter six of the revised statutes, relating to the taxation of property of religious societies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

All the property of any religious society in this state,
2 both real and personal, except its meeting-house and
3 vestry, and the furniture therein, shall be liable to
4 taxation the same as other property.
