IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

[S. 56.] AN ACT to amend section nine, chapter one hundred and sixteen of the revised statutes, relating to support of prisoners in jails.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section nine of chapter one hundred and sixteen of  
2 the revised statutes, is hereby amended, by striking  
3 out the words "three dollars" in said section, and  
4 inserting in place thereof the words "two dollars and  
5 fifty cents," so that said section, as amended, shall  
6 read as follows :

7 *Sect. 9.* The jailor's fees for the commitment or  
8 or discharge of a prisoner shall be twenty cents ; and  
9 for the entire support of each prisoner of every de-

10 scription committed to his custody, such sum, not  
11 exceeding at the rate of two dollars and fifty cents a  
12 week, as the county commissioners judge reasonable.
