STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

[S. 56.] AN ACT to amend section nine, chapter one hundred and sixteen of the revised statutes, relating to support of prisoners in jails.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section nine of chapter one hundred and sixteen of

- 2 the revised statutes, is hereby amended, by striking
- 3 out the words "three dollars" in said section, and
- 4 inserting in place thereof the words "two dollars and
- 5 fifty cents," so that said section, as amended, shall
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sect. 9. The jailor's fees for the commitment or
- 8 or discharge of a prisoner shall be twenty cents; and
- 9 for the entire support of each prisoner of every de-

- 10 scription committed to his custody, such sum, not
- 11 exceeding at the rate of two dollars and fifty cents a
- 12 week, as the county commissioners judge reasonable.
