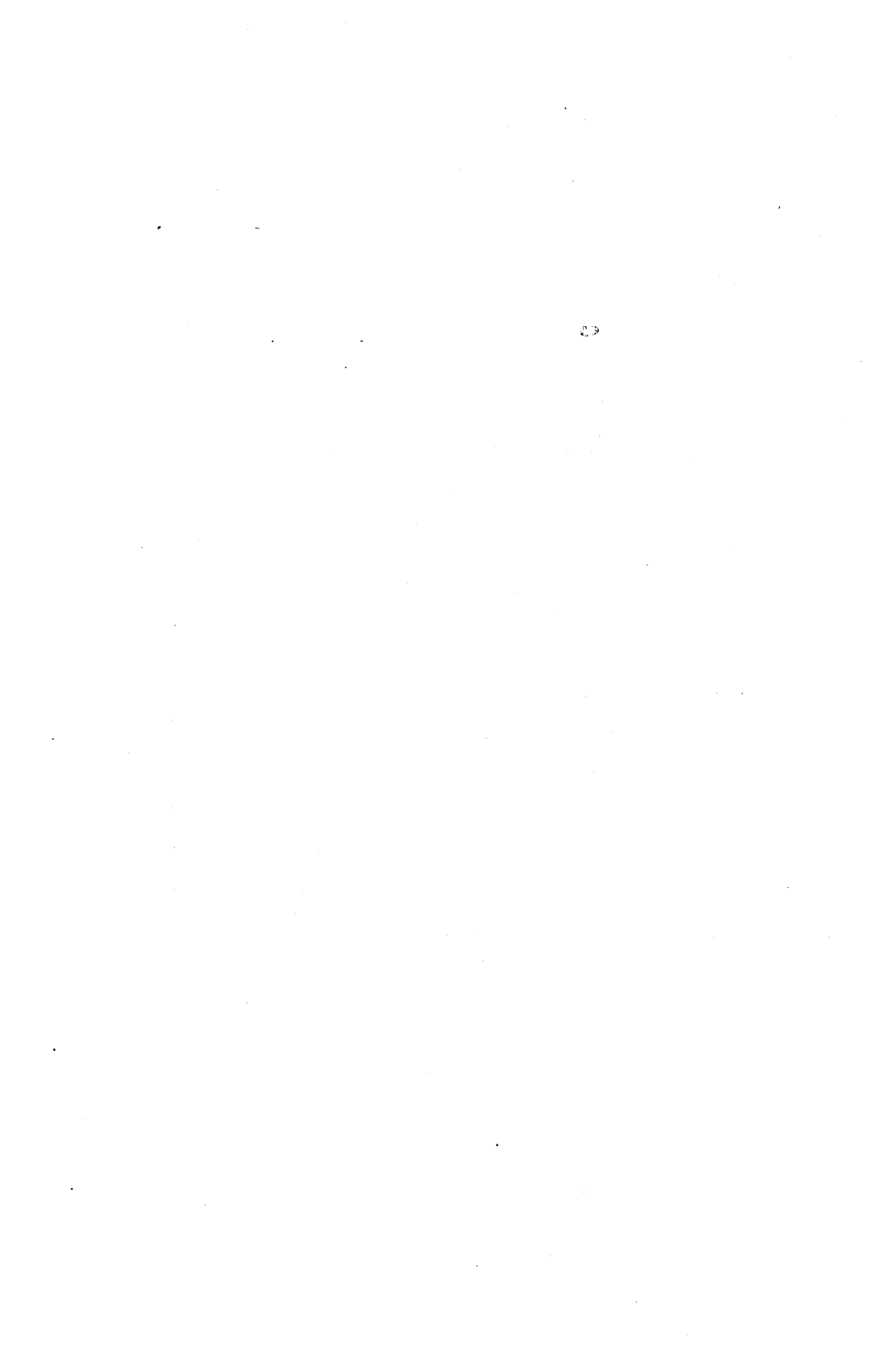
## STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 19.] RESOLVE in favor of compiling and printing  
the school laws.

---

*Resolved,* That the superintendent of common schools  
2 be and hereby is instructed and empowered to cause  
3 the laws of this state relating to public schools, to in-  
4 clude the laws passed at the present session relating to  
5 the same, to be compiled, and five thousand copies  
6 printed and distributed among the several cities,  
7 towns and plantations in this state, the whole cost not  
8 to exceed five hundred dollars.
